PRINCIPAL'S REPORT



Hi everyone,

It is unbelievable how quickly this year is going! We have quite a few events organised between now and the end of the year so please take the time to read the important information in this report.

Concert- Students have been working hard on this and are excited to perform. Entrance to the concert is by ticket only, **if you don't have a ticket you will be unable to stay** as seats have been allocated. Spaces are limited so if you request a ticket now you will be put on a waiting list until we can confirm space. If you can no longer attend please inform us. Please arrive at 1:15 to be seated. You can order a USB or DVD for \$5.00.

Pupil Free Day- Monday 12th October Week 1, Term 4

As we had to cancel two pupil free days in term 1, we have been authorised by the Department and the Governing Council to replace one with Monday 12th October. All staff will learn how to plan for students with additional learning needs and also how to support early signs of disengaged behaviour. This will be a productive day for staff and we appreciate your support in this.

Sports Day Week 5, Thursday 12th November

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, I regret to say that our sports day will be a student only event for 2020. The management and tracking of all adults on site to ensure their safety is too difficult with such an open event so the Governing Council have supported this decision in the safety of students, parents and staff. We know this is a huge community event for the school and the day will not feel the same, but classes will think of creative ways to share memories of the day with you.

School Improvement Plan (SIP) Refinement- Based on feedback from our progress meeting with our Education Director, Ros Maio, we worked as a staff team to reduce our 2020 SIP from one goal to two. This supports our narrow focus on Phonemic Awareness and Phonics. We have had a 20% average increase in phonics assessment scores across the school from term 1 to term 2 and term 3 assessments will begin soon.

Parent Survey- The 2020 parent engagement survey opened on Monday 7 September. You should have received a link via email or text. It is an opportunity for parents to provide feedback on their school and your feedback will help us understand: What we are doing well, where we can improve and what is really important to you as a parent.

Materials and Services Charge- The prescribed amount for the Materials and Services Charge for 2020 has raised by \$2 to \$246. School card will be adjusted to compensate for this. If you have any questions about this please contact the Governing Council or attend our next meeting on Wednesday week 3.

Early Arrival to School- We have noticed more and more students arriving at school prior to 8:30. No staff are on duty prior to 8:30 so please encourage your children not to arrive before then unless it is to access breakfast club from 8am.

Enrol now for 2021- If you know of any children eligible to start reception next year please encourage their families to enrol now. Additionally, if you are planning on leaving the school next year please inform admin staff. We will start organising classes for next year soon!
