# Room 20 and 21

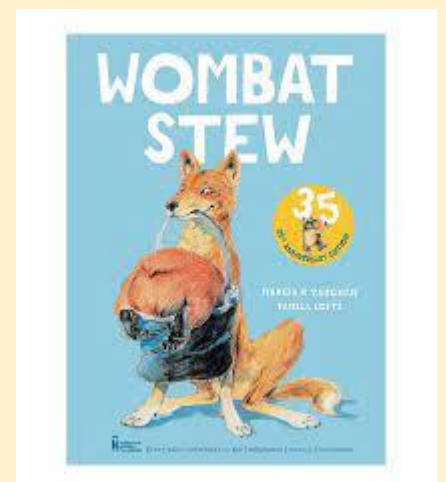
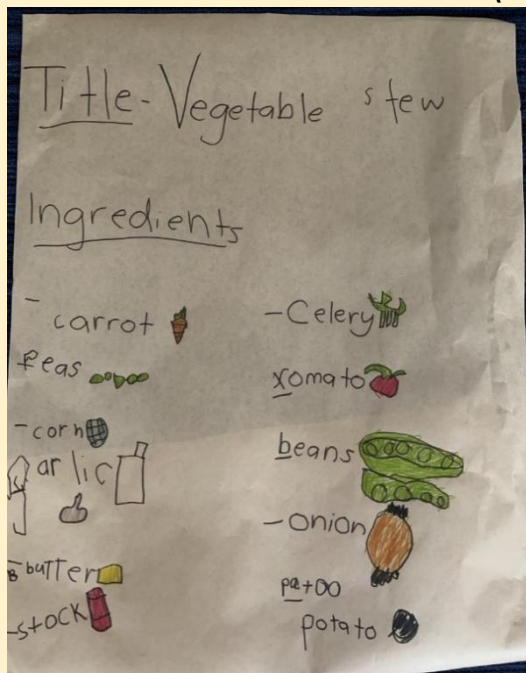
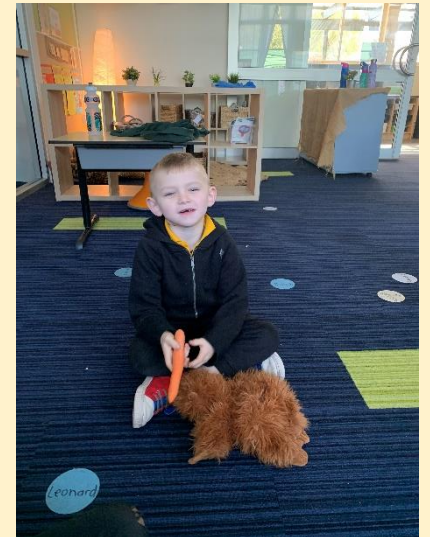


This term, Room 20 and 21 have been reading the book 'Wombat Stew'.
