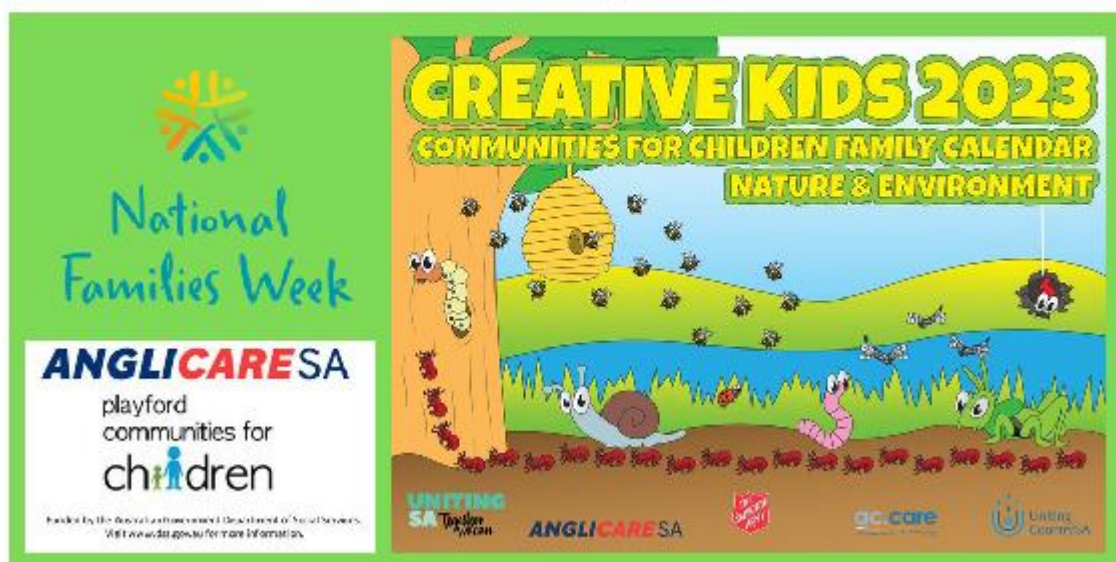

We need your vote to select who will win a prize to help select the Art to be included into 2024 calendar.

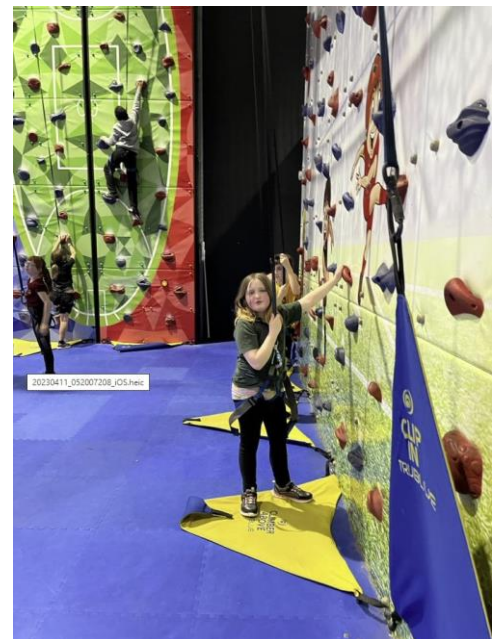
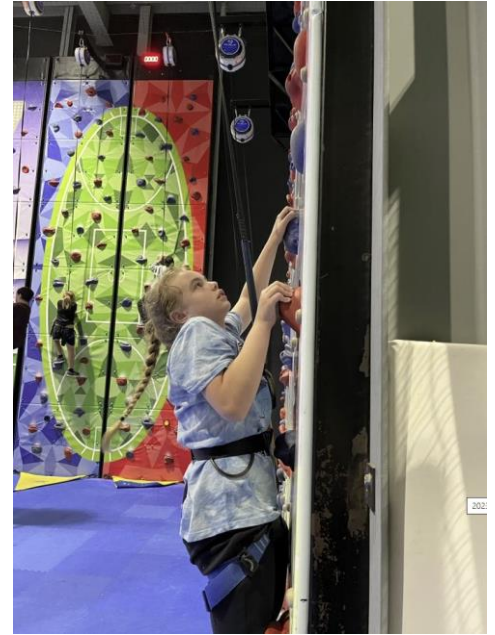
