Dear Parents and Caregivers,  
Welcome back to Term 4 to all our families and I hope you had a wonderful holiday break!

**Street Smart Program:** As part of Healthy Body, Healthy Mind this term we have arranged for RAA to present their Street Smart Program to each class in Week 3. Each session will run for 45 minutes and will address the areas of pedestrian safety, passenger safety, wheeled safety and maintaining your wheels. These lessons involve safe, interactive and hands on learning opportunities. All lessons are linked to the Australian Curriculum for Health and Physical Education and aim to be an enriching experience for your child/children.

**External School Review:** On Monday and Tuesday of week 4 we will have two visitors joining us from the Review and Improvement Team within the Department. They will be visiting classrooms and talking to teachers, leadership, and Governing Council about aspects of our school. They will then give us improvement recommendations moving forward.
