Dear Parents and Caregivers,

# 2023 EGPS SPORTS DAY

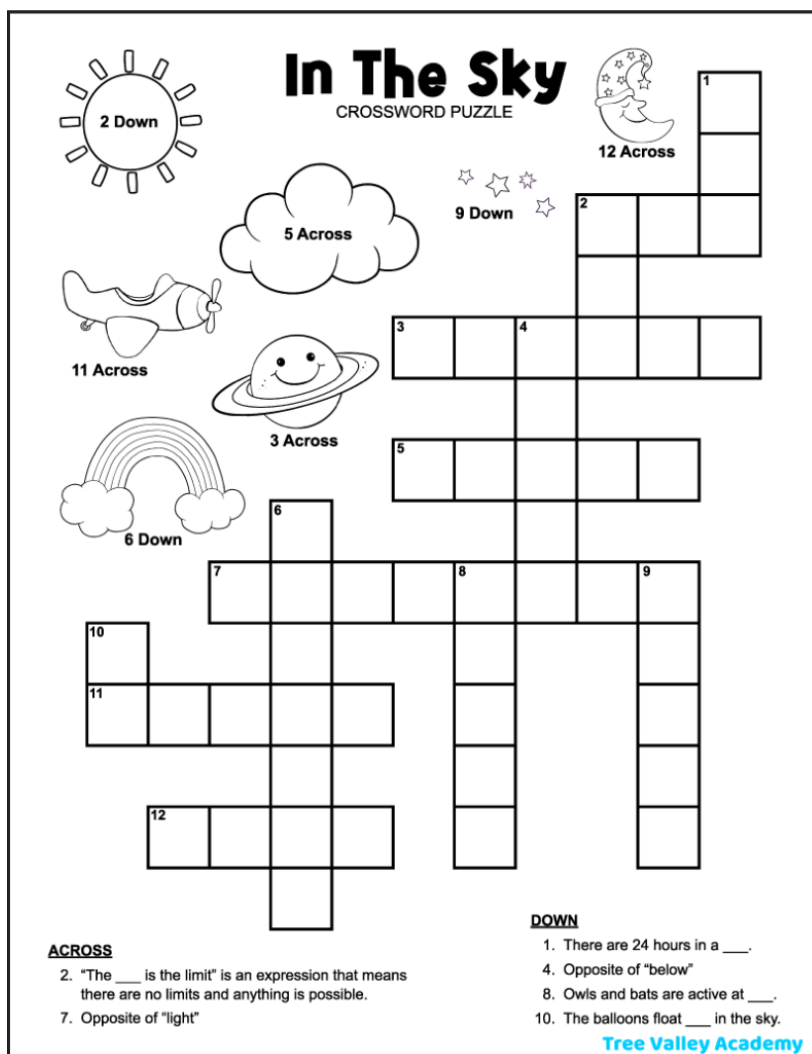
