Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome back to term 2! I hope you enjoyed the holiday break with your families. The teachers and students have come back eager to jump into their learning.

Mother's Day Stall- Thank you to our Governing Council who will be running this stall on Thursday the 9th of May for students to purchase gifts for their loved ones. We hope you get something special on Mother's Day and enjoy the day.

Facilities upgrades- Work has continued for our new Bike/Scooter enclosure over the holidays and we are looking forward to finalising this over the term.
