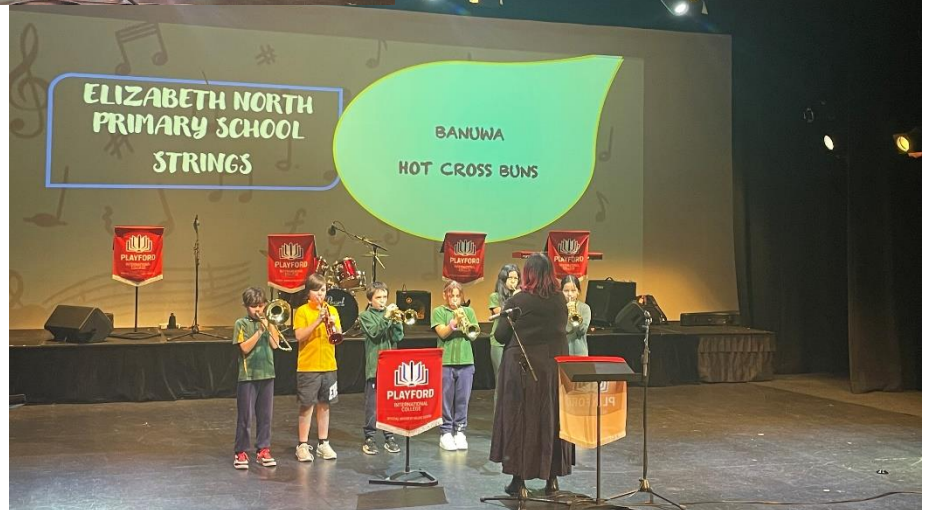
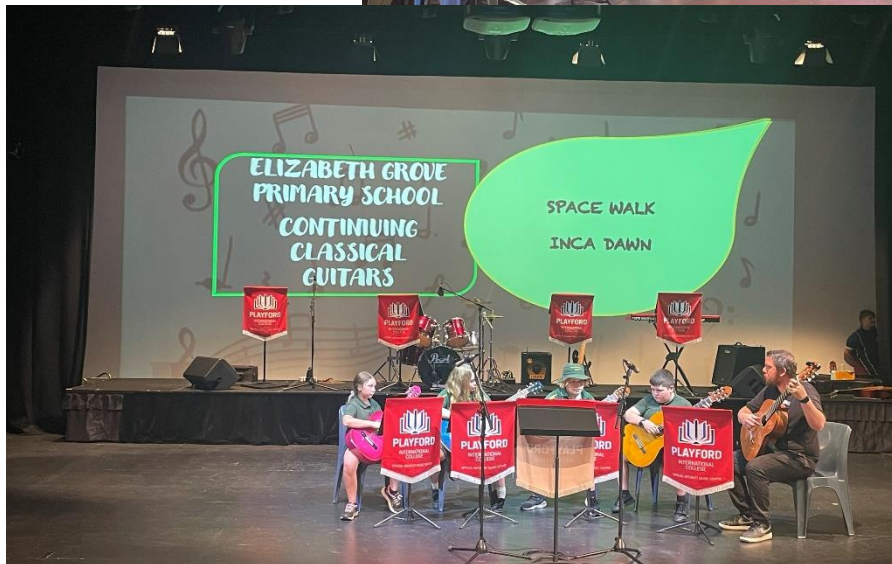
Year 6 Aquatics
