Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Thank you all for the effort you put into Harmony Week, whether it was attending our assembly or supporting your children to wear cultural or orange clothing, I feel it was the strongest year in recognising the over 50 cultures we are lucky to have as part of our school community.



NAPLAN: Our year 3 and 5 students have completed all their NAPLAN testing and I am extremely proud of how they approached the test and gave them all a good go. Reports will be sent home later in the year once we receive them.

Teacher Release for Planning: You may have heard more occasions of teachers being released from their classes at the moment. Each teacher receives half a day each term for co-planning their English units with their teaching teams. They also have access to three release days to use across the year to support personalised planning for their complex classes. This is all time well spent to make teaching and learning strong in our classrooms.

Swimming: Our Year 3-5 students will be engaging in swimming lessons across the whole of this week. Year R-2 will have their lessons in week 2 of term 3. Year 6 will engage in aquatics in week 3 of term 4.


